

Oklahoma's Annual Sales Tax Holiday

- Takes place the first Friday in August, beginning at 12:01 a.m., and ending the following Sunday at 12:00 a.m.
- Is in effect throughout the state of Oklahoma. Retailers are required to participate and may not charge tax on items that are legally tax-exempt during the sales tax holiday.
- Also lifts any county or city sales taxes, which are reimbursed to the localities by the state.
- Applies to all shoes and clothing under \$100 per item.
- Does not apply to “accessories, special clothing or footwear primarily designed for athletic activity or protective use that is not normally worn except when used for athletic activity or protective use, or to the rental of clothing or footwear.”
