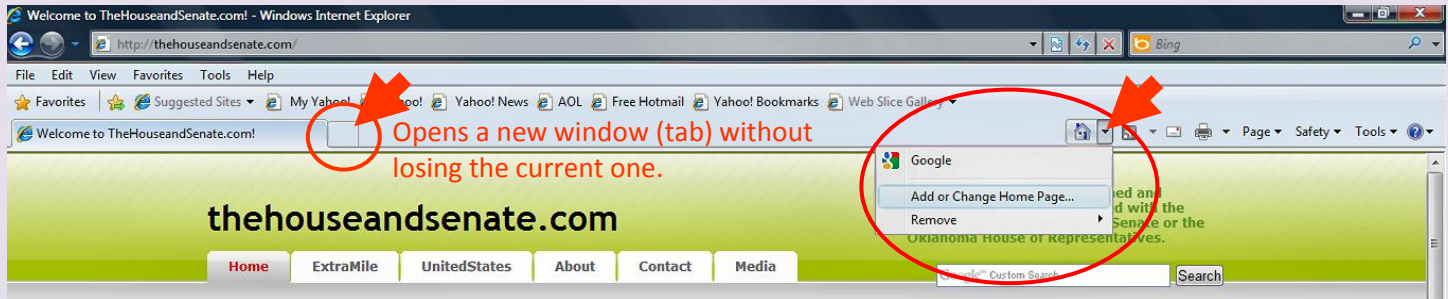


## INTERNET EXPLORER – ADD HOME PAGE TABS

Internet Explorer 7 and later versions can open the web pages you visit most frequently – without you having to retype them in every time you wish to visit. Simply add more home pages, and all of your home pages will open automatically when you open Explorer. If you have an earlier version than Explorer 7, request an upgrade from your IT guys.

Go the web site you wish to visit; in this case, a shameless plug for thehouseandsenate.com. 😊



Click on the down arrow by the house icon close to the top of your screen.

Select “Add or Change Home Page” and then “Add this webpage to your home page tabs.”

Do this for as many web sites as you like. Most recently added sites will be added at the right end of your line of tabs.
