

OPEN TABS IN EXPLORER, without minimizing windows

Did you know that you can open more than one web site at a time in Internet Explorer, without minimizing windows?



- Open Internet Explorer (the “e” button).
- At the top of your window is a tab called “Home,” or the name of the web site you are currently visiting.
- Click on the small, “hiding” tab to the right of that.
- In the top browser window, type in the new web site address.
- Now you can alternate between tabs, which is much easier than minimizing your Explorer windows.
